

Requirements for Renewing Your Registration

You must complete the following three mandatory articling courses within your initial two year registration cycle in order to have your salesperson registration renewed for the first time: Real Property Law, the remaining Residential Real Estate Transaction or Commercial Real Estate Transaction (not completed for your initial registration), and one of four elective courses.

For all subsequent registration renewals, all broker and salesperson registrants must accumulate 24 continuing education (CE) credits in continuing education courses/seminars during each two-year registration cycle. All continuing education courses/seminars completed to maintain registration under REBBA 2002, must be courses/seminars approved by the Registrar. Salespersons who have completed the articling educational requirements may pursue broker registration. Requirements for registration as a broker include being employed as a salesperson for at least 24 of the 36 months immediately preceding the date of the application. The educational requirements for becoming a Broker include taking an elective course not taken in the articling segment and the Real Estate Broker Course. Registrants who have successfully completed the Real Estate Broker Course must submit an application for registration as a broker to **RECO** within 12 months of successfully completing the Real Estate Broker course examination.
